

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR
MIDWEST OPERATING ENGINEERS
RETIREMENT ENHANCEMENT FUND

This is a summary of the annual report for the Midwest Operating Engineers, Retirement Enhancement Fund, employer identification number 51-0669630 for the year ended May 31, 2010. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by the Trust and by a guaranteed insurance contract. Plan expenses were \$713,816. These expenses included \$553,477 in administrative expenses and \$160,339 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 9,649 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$15,780,249 as of May 31, 2010 compared to \$5,646,552 as of May 31, 2009. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$10,133,697. The plan had total income of \$10,847,513 including employer contributions of \$9,705,753, rollovers into the plan of \$582, and income from investments of \$1,141,178.

2. Financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. Assets held for investment;
4. Fiduciary information, including non-exempt transactions between the plan and parties in interest (that is, persons who have certain relationships with the plan);
5. Transactions in excess of 5 percent of plan assets, and
6. Information regarding any common or collective trusts, pooled separate accounts; master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates

You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan at 6150 Joliet Road, Countryside, Illinois and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C. or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
